Wie möchten Euch zu unserer nächsten Veranstaltung einladen. Die Vortragende ist Chileshe Gloria Mange (Windhoek, Namibia), sie spricht über:

HIV/Aids in Namibia. Update on current developments

Chileshe Gloria Mange is currently a freelance consultant with a background in human biology and community health, as well as five years experience in a non-governmental organization at a senior management level. Her lecture will be in English language.

Namibia is a vast country that has been and remains at the epicenter of the HIV and AIDS pandemic since the global catastrophe became known to society. According to a 2010 survey, the national prevalence stands at 18.8% - the third highest prevalence in the world after Swaziland and Botswana respectively. The Namibian government follows a multi-sectoral approach involving working with policy makers, receiving technical and financial assistance from international donors and more substantially, partnering with civil society organisations. However, the social impact of HIV in Namibia has been catastrophic, with over 250.000 orphans and vulnerable children. The reasons for this are many, among them poor practical implementation of policies and social interventions.
